#### THE DANISH WINDMILL

#### Hours: Saturday 9 am - 6 pm

Tour the 1848 Danish Windmill celebrating 46 years in America. Built in 1848 in Nørre Snede, Denmark, & brought to America in 1975. Rebuilt by community volunteers to honor the area's strong Danish heritage. Visit the VikingHjem, Morning Star Chapel, and Ebeltoft Village.

#### VIKING ENCAMPMENT

Throughout the day on the Viking Grounds and at the VikingHjem The VikingHjem demonstrates a typical structure used throughout Scandinavia and Northern Europe during the latter Dark Ages to the early Middle ages. You can experience the life of a Viking Smithy in 900 A.D. from the blacksmith shop and woodworking area to the ax throwing demonstrations and lectures.
